## Get Students Access to the Right Tools Before Fall

Whether you're running a yearbook team, a design class, or PLTW engineering, access to industry software shouldn't depend on lab space, hardware, or your IT teams.

### ? Quick Questions to Ask Yourself:

- ➡ Can my students access tools like Adobe Photoshop or AutoCAD during class time?
- ➡ What happens when a student misses a lab session or is working from home?
- ➡ How often am I troubleshooting installs or login issues? How often am I placing an IT ticket?
- ➡ Are software requirements holding back certification goals?

### 4 Low-Lift Improvements:

- ✓ Use browser-based tools where possible *(taking strain off your available devices)*
- ✓ Take it one class at a time. Pilot access with one class now.
- ✓ Collaborate with IT early to minimize fall delays
- ✓ Track which students struggle with access
